I will speak directly to the Camp Director before removing my child, at anytime, from the camp grounds.

I authorize the dispensing of medications that accompany my child and the dispensing of common over-the-counter medications that might be needed. I give the camp personnel the authority to act on my behalf in case of an emergency, including medical treatment. (Parent/Guardian will be notified as soon as possible). I understand that I am financial responsible for costs incurred. I agree to the release of any records necessary for insurance purposes.

I hereby release KCBC and its personnel from all claims for damages arising from any accident or injury caused by my child's participation in the camp program.
